PERSONAL KIT LIST

All Team members are expected to carry a basic level of equipment when on the hill. Listed beneath are the items that you would be expected to carry in your Rucksack or wear whilst training with the Team:

- Waterproof Top
- Waterproof Leggings
- Spare dry clothing
- Hat & Gloves
- 1:25000 Map x 2
- Compass
- GPS
- Whistle
- Pencil and Paper
- Survival/Bivvy Bag
- KISU (Sometimes known as a Bothy Bag)
- Karrimat
- Sleeping Bag
- Personal 1st Aid kit
- Emergency rations
- Head Torch (plus spare batteries)
- Flask

When you become a callout member you would also be expected to carry the following items:

- Climbing Helmet
- Confidence Rope (10m)
- Search Torch (plus spare batteries)
- Slings and Karabiners
